

#### How to order

These are the tools I recommend working with in the online metalsmithing course. You can place your order at www.gesswein.com. They are based in the United States but will ship worldwide. **With the code EST21 you will receive a 5% discount** on almost all of their tools. You can use this code over and over again.

#### Not included

Precious metals and gemstones are not included in this set. I would advise you to start out with brass or alpaca to practice with. Some sheet metal from 1,5 mm thick and wire in thicknesses 1 and 2 mm will be a great starting point.

### Advised

Next to these basic tools a flex shaft or micro motor is advised. I have used both and am a total fan of the marathon micro motor system. You can find a tutorial on this system on my youtube channel. Haven't touched my flex shaft since I received the micro motor. It truly is a great system to use. This is the article number: 5102956.

Before soldering a soldering setup is necessary. Unfortunately Gesswein does not provide the soldering setup I use at the moment, but I am hoping this will change shortly. You can use this Durston handheld torch for the moment to get started: 8300014. You can refill it with this butane fluid: 8300012. This will get you started with soldering but when you are going to melt and cast silver or gold you will need more serious equipment.
